

Why We Use Petlink SLIM Microchips

PetLink microchips come multiple enrollement options for animal professionals.

PetLink allows pet parents to have 3 contacts and medical information in profile, as well as a pet photo for easier identification. Many registries only allow 1 or 2 contacts.

Pet owners have access to Free Lost Pet posters and Social Media prepared posts.

When a pet goes missing there are 3 forms of communication, texts, emails, and phone calls sent to pet owners and the alternate contacts when the pet is reported Found.

PetLink's call center answers missing/found calls 24/7/365 and is in the U.S.

The **PetLink SLIM** microchips are made of a polymer rather than glass like all other microchips on the market. This lightweight polymer is not as heavy as glass and can prevent it from moving/migrating in the pet.

PetLink microchips are delivered in a smaller needle than traditional glass microchips making implanting easier and causing less stress for pets.

PetLink SLIM microchips have an excellent read distance making them easier to find/read when pets are scanned. Other small mini or nano chips are hard to detect or find because their antennae are shorter, and scanners may not be able to detect.

PetLink is recognized both in the U.S. through AHAA and globally through the Petmaxx search engines worldwide protection of Lost/Found pets.

PetLink.net is easy for pet parents as well as animal professionals to register pets.

The 981 prefix (ICAR manufacturing code) of PetLink microchips is recognized worldwide. Generic 900 and 991 numbers identify with sometimes 5 different companies and cannot be searched worldwide, making reunification of lost/found pets more difficult or impossible.

The quality of PetLink microchips ensures the chips will keep working for the lifetime of the pet. Some inexpensively made chips, do not keep working the lifetime of the pet.
